As part of a statewide education program, Rich Mountain Conservation District is offering a first place \$1000 scholarship and a \$500 second place scholarship for a local high school senior according to James Watkins, Chairman of the district. As well as receiving the local district scholarship, the winner will be eligible to compete at both the area and state level. The Arkansas Association of Conservation Districts awards two scholarships (\$1,000 and \$500) based on student's essay.

Flexible hours of work will be between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Work involves various outside jobs and some office duties.


